TOGG "Tales": Woodsman Adventure 2013

In the 90s, Goose and I took a couple of canoe trips to Quetico Provincial Park. This summer, I'm going back for another trip, and I'm wondering if there are any Kenan people who might be inclined to come along for the journey?

Quetico is in Ontario, just north of the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness of Minnesota. It consists of over 1 million acres of woods, lakes, and streams that remains much like it was hundreds of years ago. Rather than provide a full description, I recommend you simply do a Google search on Quetico Provincial Park. Also, go on YouTube and do a search on "Quetico canoe trip"; you'll find some pretty good videos. Finally, go to canoetrip.com to check out the outfitter I use, Canadian Border Outfitters.

My plan is to go sometime between mid-July and the end of August. Permits are required, so I will be selecting a date by the end of March.

I'm thinking 7-10 days for the canoe trip, plus two travel days each way. Up to 9 people can travel on a permit; I'm going solo or with up to 8 other people.
